What is the Thoroughbred Exhibitors Association?

The TBEA is a 501(c)(3) non-profit association that promotes the Thoroughbred as a talented sport and pleasure horse with heart and stamina across all disciplines.

Membership is open to any level of horse lover - from those brand new to horses to experienced horse people; our common cause is the support of the Thoroughbred horse.

You do not need to have a Thoroughbred (or any horse) to join this group or participate in shows.

What do we do?

The club typically runs two shows a year. Class lists at our Spring show include Halter, Western, English, Jumping, Trail (E/W), Driving, and Pleasure. The Fall shows include Dressage, Combined Tests (CT) and Derby (DX). A variety of prizes are offered by the club, as well as prizes from the Jockey Club's TIP program.

Throughout the year, we often get together to participate in activities such as group trail rides and clinics as suggested by our members.

Awards

We hold year-end award ceremonies to recognize the efforts of our members in various riding disciplines (dressage, eventing, endurance, trail and more!) as well as other contributions in support of the club's values. Your thoroughbred must be registered with TBEA to earn points, for which there is a \$10 fee, but this only has to be done once per horse, with no renewal required.

Our club is powered by volunteers: **each TBEA member volunteers a minimum of five hours of their time annually at a TBEA sanctioned show (or a volunteer substitute) to qualify for year-end awards.** You do not need to volunteer to win high-point awards at a show.
