~ Helmets required for riders under 18; Encouraged for all riders.

- ~ Stallions must be shown by handler 18 years or older.
- ~ No penalty for humane schooling devices, attire, or hairy horses.
- ~ Novice horses and riders – less than 3 blue ribbons.
- ~ Lead line – No Cross Entry.
- ~ Colored Horse – must show visible color.
- ~ Register TBs with TBEA or show proof of registry for all TB classes.
- ~ TIP number required for TIP awards - <http://tjctip.com>.

~ High Points

- ~ Must show in Showmanship and Equitation to be eligible.
- ~ TB / ½ TB Showmanship with age division.
- ~ 13 and Under – 11, 15, 16, 27, 28, 44, 45, 56, 57
- ~ 14-18 – 12, 17, 18, 29, 30, 46, 47, 58, 59
- ~ 19-39 – 13, 19, 20, 31, 32, 48, 49, 60, 61
- ~ 40 and Over – 14, 21, 22, 33, 34, 50, 51, 62, 63
- ~ TB / ½ TB – 23, 24, 35, 36, 52, 53, 64, 65

Prices, Prizes, Rules, Release, and Entry

Prices:

- ~ Pre-entry fee - \$7 per class / \$80 All-day pass, if postmarked before April 30th.
- ~ Post-entry fee - \$9 per class / \$100 All-day pass.
- ~ Office Fee - \$6 per rider/horse.
- ~ Stall Fee - \$30 for Saturday night and Sunday. Horses may be stalled after 4:00pm on May 6th. You are NOT required to clean your stall prior to departure.
- ~ Haul In Fee - \$10 per horse. Tying to trailers is allowed, but area must be clean before departure.

Prizes:

- ~ High Points will be awarded for each age division and the TB / ½ TB division. Classes that count towards high points are listed on the reverse side.
- ~ Prizes will be given to 1st place recipients from each class.
- ~ TIP awards will be awarded for the following divisions – TB English Pleasure W/T/C Junior Rider, Junior Rider High Point, Hunter High Point, TB Overall, TB Western Pleasure W/J/L, and TB English Pleasure W/T/C.
- ~ 1st place in the Dressage Suitability class will be awarded with their choice of \$150 to Pure Harmony Equine Apparel, or an English Bridle. 2nd place will be awarded with their choice of \$75 to Pure Harmony Equine Apparel, or English Reins.

Rules:

- ~ Helmets are required for riders under 18, ALL riders in hunter hack classes, and encouraged for all.
- ~ Classes that are not labeled W/T or W/J, are walk/trot/canter or walk/jog/lope for English and Western classes, respectively. Gaited horses may substitute as needed by their breed.
- ~ Novice horses and riders are not to have won more than 3 blue ribbons in that division.
- ~ Every rider will be required to sign a facility release from Oregon Equestrian Center prior to riding.
- ~ OHSET Hunt Seat and Stock Seat Equitation classes are pattern classes. The patterns can be found at <http://www.ohset.com/events.php>.

Release: I accept and clearly understand that riding a horse can be hazardous, especially in an equestrian event; that there are inherent and other risks involved in riding a horse; and that injuries are a common and ordinary occurrence. I freely accept and assume those risks. I therefore release Thoroughbred Exhibitors Association (TBEA), its members, the show grounds owners and all of their agents and employees from any and all liability for damage and injury to myself, my horse, or to any person or property resulting from riding or showing a horse in this equestrian event, accepting myself the full responsibility for any and all such damage or injury of any kind which may result. I agree to fully indemnify, defend, and hold TBEA, show grounds owners and all their agents and employees harmless from any and all claims, actions, liability or costs including attorney fees and other costs of defense arising out of or in any way related to my riding or showing a horse in this event. The limitations on liability provided in ORS 30.691 shall apply to an adult participant in the circumstances listed in subsection (1) (b) of this section if the participant, prior to riding, training, driving, grooming or riding as a passenger upon an equine, knowingly executes a release stating that as a condition of participation, the a participant waives the right to bring an action against the equine professional or activity sponsor for an injury or death arising out of riding, training, driving, grooming or riding as a passenger upon an equine. A release so executes shall be binding upon the adult participant.
